NARRATIVE

On Saturday, December 6, 2025, I, Officer Mayette was working the Nantucket Stroll detail located in the downtown district. At approximately 2:04pm, all downtown units were advised of a physical altercation in progress in the area of 21 Federal Street. Dispatch advised responding units that there was multiple 911 calls regarding the physical altercation.

While enroute to the scene via foot, I heard multiple statements from civilians which included "did you see that guy go flying during the fight," "oh good here they (the Nantucket Police Department) come," and "that was bad." Upon arrival, I observed multiple male and female parties arguing in the middle of the roadway in front of 21 Federal Street and a large crowd gathered on the sidewalk and in the street. This portion of Federal Street was open to vehicular traffic at the time of the altercation. I observed Officer Thompson on scene speaking to multiple male and female parties and attempting to separate the parties.

A male party who was later identified as [REDACTED] approached me and stated that his [REDACTED], [REDACTED], "was smashed in the face by this guy in the white jacket." [REDACTED] [REDACTED], then stated [REDACTED] I then spoke to [REDACTED], [REDACTED] [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] stated [REDACTED]s were inside The Boarding House Restaurant. It should be of note that at this time, The Boarding House was heavily occupied. [REDACTED] stated a male party who was later identified as [REDACTED] who was wearing a light-colored jacket and white baseball hat, was making [REDACTED]. It should be of note that a CJIS inquiry did not reveal [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] continued to state that due to the Boarding House being crowded, she accidentally bumped into [REDACTED] in which [REDACTED] requested she stop pushing up against him in the bar. She then stated [REDACTED]'s friends began to get aggressive. These friends were identified as [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. According to [REDACTED], [REDACTED] then made a comment to [REDACTED] about her. [REDACTED] then asked [REDACTED] not to talk to [REDACTED] in that manner. [REDACTED] stated that at this time, [REDACTED] went after her and [REDACTED], and a fight began and escalated.

█████ stated that she was struck on the right side of her face by █████. She could not remember if █████'s fist was open or closed at the time of being struck. I did observe red markings. See attached photograph. █████ did not wish to receive medical care or pursue criminal charges.

I then asked █████ if █████ was still on scene in which she stated he was not. She then called █████ who did not answer his cellphone, and she did not have his location. At this time, I am still attempting to obtain a statement from █████.

I was then advised that two male parties who were standing on Oak Street were involved in the physical altercation and that they attempted to punch █████, █████ of █████, during the initial altercation. At this time, █████, █████ of █████, approached these previously described males on Oak Street and stated, "he's instigating." Upon Officer Thompson and I speaking to this male, he refused to provide his name or identifying information. He continued to state that he was not involved in the physical altercation and did not observe anything. He then stated, "you saw how he (█████) came after me. That's just what he did over there." This male party then stated he broke up the fight inside The Boarding House and then went into the restroom. Upon exiting The Boarding House, he stated everyone was fighting and all he did was push everyone apart and that he didn't know what occurred at the beginning of the altercation, but that █████ came after him.

This male party continued to state that when he went out onto Federal Street, a friend of his was thrown to the ground. He stated █████ was the party who pushed his friend and was "provoking everything" and stating "that's my █████. Someone punched my █████." He then stated the same group that provoked him on Oak Street is the same group that provoked him when the fight broke out.

I then spoke to █████. I observed █████ right middle knuckle to have a bloody laceration on it. █████ refused medical attention. He then stated that his knuckle was injured as a "guy hit █████ in the face." Upon asking █████ who hit his █████ in the face, he stated "the man in the white hat" who was identified as █████. █████ stated he and his family were in the enclosed patio of The Boarding House. █████ and his family were getting ready to leave when he observed █████ step in front of █████ as █████ was being aggressive towards █████. He then observed █████, █████, and █████ make contact with █████. At this time, █████ stepped into the physical altercation and was then pulled away by an individual he did not recognize or could remember. █████ did not observe which individual made contact with the other individual first.

I then spoke to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] were at the entrance of The Boarding House requesting to go inside from the bouncer. She then observed a "guy in the fight" who lunged at [REDACTED] and then pointed to [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] then made a grabbing motion towards [REDACTED] resulting in the laceration to [REDACTED] knuckle. Everyone was then pushing one another according to [REDACTED].

The Nantucket Current Instagram page posted a video of the physical altercation. See attached videos. Upon observing additional involved individuals from these videos, I attempted to make contact with [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] in an attempt to identify these parties. Multiple voicemails were left for [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], and I have not yet received a call back. I made contact with [REDACTED] who provided the name [REDACTED] who was his friend and an involved party. As [REDACTED] was looking for [REDACTED]'s phone number, the phone line went dead. Upon calling [REDACTED] back, I was unable to make contact or leave a voicemail numerous times.

I received a phone call from a [REDACTED] who stated he was at the Boarding House at the time of the incident. [REDACTED] stated he was being pushed around and then observed a fight occurring behind him. He continued to state that a male party wearing a white baseball hat was the "most aggressive" out of the two male parties who were in a physical altercation. [REDACTED] could not identify the other male party but stated he was wearing a dark blue vest. [REDACTED] then stated that the male in the white baseball hat was going after "the other guy" and that this is all the information he could recall.

On December 7, 2025, I made contact with [REDACTED] via telephone. [REDACTED] stated she made the final decision not to pursue criminal charges and wishes to move on from this incident. Upon requesting [REDACTED]'s contact information, she refused to provide it.

I then called Abigail Ayre who stated she would be sending Sergeant J. Hollis surveillance footage from the incident.

At this time, this case remains under investigation as the primary aggressor cannot be determined, and no involved parties wish to pursue criminal charges. Upon receiving additional information regarding this case, a supplemental report will be completed.

NARRATIVE

On Saturday December 6th, 2025 at approximately at approximately 2:00 P.M. officers were dispatched to the area of Federal Street for the report of a large fight. Dispatch advised responding officers that there were multiple calls regarding the fight. I, Sgt. J.Hollis along with Ofc. McNeilly and Ofc. Paterson responded to Federal Street.

Upon arrival there were large groups of people in the street and on the sidewalk. It is of note that the street was partially blocked due to the stroll activities happening in town. I exited the cruiser and approached Ofc. Thompson who was speaking with two individuals. Ofc. Thompson relayed their information to dispatch as I spoke with the two men who were identified as [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that he and his friend were at the bar talking to people. He stated that [REDACTED] he was talking to at the bar asked him why he was talking to his [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that all of a sudden, [REDACTED] started punching him and [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that he has a house on Nantucket and has been on the island for approximately 20 years. [REDACTED] was asked which kid hit him, he stated that he left. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] strangled [REDACTED]. I asked [REDACTED] how he was strangled, he stated he "choke hold me and threw me to the ground". I then asked him if this was done with the kid's hands or arm, he stated his elbow. [REDACTED] stated that he would like to press charges. I asked him for a description of the kid who did this to him to which he could not provide any information. [REDACTED] reiterated that he would like to press charges and that the [REDACTED] keeps threatening him. He then stated that he wanted a restraining order against the [REDACTED]. I asked what the kid said when he was threatening him, he stated he threatened to kill him and strangled him.

After speaking with the two male parties, I then updated Ofc. Thompson with what was told to me. At this time Ofc. McNeilly walked up to us and advised us that a female who was struck [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] I then went to the Boarding House to speak with the staff due to the incident taking place inside the establishment. I first spoke with the manager, Abigail Ayre who stated she called 9-1-1 but that she did not witness anything however a patron did and stated she would go get him. I then spoke with [REDACTED], who stated that man in the white hat "full extended, knocked her in the face and then it went nuts". [REDACTED] was asked what happened leading up to the fight, he stated he didn't know but there was a back and forth, people were screaming and that he thought the female that was struck [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was asked if the man in the white hat purposely meant to hit the female, he stated he the man in the white hate didn't see who he was hitting. [REDACTED] asked if

there was anything else he could remember, he stated that the female was not aggressive and that she was just trying to get something from the bar. [REDACTED] was asked if he saw the man in the brown coat being choked, he stated no.

I then spoke with the female victim, [REDACTED] who stated that she saw [REDACTED] getting thrown on the floor, [REDACTED] getting hit in the face along with [REDACTED] getting hit in the face. She stated that she doesn't want to ruin someone's life and needs a second to think. [REDACTED] stated that she is on the 2:45 P.M. ferry back to Hyannis. [REDACTED] asked for 24 hours to think about whether or not she wanted to press charges. [REDACTED] asked to know what would happen if she did want to press charges, in which the process was explain if she did or did not want to press charges. [REDACTED] did confirm with me that she [REDACTED], [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] decided that she just wanted a record of what happened at this time and did not wish to press charges. [REDACTED] was asked if she needed any medical attention to which she declined. Ofc. Thompson advised the female that she would call her in a couple days and follow up with her.

I then went back to The Boarding House and spoke with Ayre about any possible camera footage from inside the establishment. Ayre stated that there are cameras that record and that she would be sending me the footage tomorrow. Once I receive the footage, it will be attached to the case.

All parties were sent on their way, see Ofc. Mayette's incident for additional information.

NARRATIVE

On 12/6/25 I, Officer McNeilly was on duty in V5. At approximately 2:05pm dispatch advised the Third-party Nantucket Stroll detail that there was a large physical altercation in the area of 12 Federal St. It should be noted I, was in the downtown area due to dropping Sgt. J Hollis and Ofc. Paterson off to their assigned details. Upon dispatch's transmission I, activated my blue lights and responded to 12 Federal St, code two.

Upon arrival, I observed a large crowd on Federal St. I also observed several Officers already talking to involved parties. I then remained in the area to keep the crowd on the sidewalk and out of the street. It should be noted numerous people were observing the large Police presence and numerous people acting erratically.

Once Officers were done with their investigation, I cleared the scene.

NARRATIVE

On December 6, 2025 I, Ofc. Thompson, was working a third party detail in the downtown area, primarily Main St, for the Nantucket Stroll. At approximately 2:05pm Dispatch requested detail officers to the area of 12 Federal St for the report of a physical altercation. At the time of the dispatch I was standing at the intersection of Main St and Federal St.

I then turned down Federal St and started to run toward the area of 12 Federal St, The Boarding House. I could see a large group of people on the sidewalk and spilling out into the roadway. It should be of note that while some streets were closed to vehicular traffic, this particular area of Federal St was open to vehicular traffic but due to the large crowd no vehicles were able to pass. As I approached the intersection of Federal St and India St I could hear people saying "it's over" and "thank god the police are here". I then approached a large group of people that were gathered in the roadway outside of 21 Federal St and were yelling at each other. I observed there to be two different groups of people and both groups continued to yell at each other and attempt to get in each other's faces as I approached and identified myself.

As I was attempting to keep the groups separated a woman, later identified as [REDACTED] kept coming up to me and saying that her [REDACTED], [REDACTED], was slapped in the face. These statements would then cause two male parties, later identified as [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] [REDACTED], to become agitated and start yelling back at [REDACTED] and her family. [REDACTED]'s family would then start yelling back at [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] This back and forth continued until more officers arrived on scene and were able to assist me with defusing the situation.

Sgt. J. Hollis, Ofc. Paterson, Ofc. Mayette, and Ofc. McNeilly arrived on scene. Ofc. Mayette was able to speak with [REDACTED] (see her report for more information), Sgt. J Hollis was then able to speak with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] (see her report), while I was able to obtain [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] information.

After an on scene investigation no parties wanted to pursue criminal charges at that immediate moment. I did advise [REDACTED] that I would follow up with her in a few days after she was able to think about the situation, [REDACTED] agreed to that. All officers then cleared the scene.
